

Covid-19 Policy

- **If your child has Covid-19 the child cannot return until a health care provider determines the child is no longer contagious.**
- If your child has been exposed to someone who was diagnosed with Covid- 19. The child will have to quarantine for 10 days or have a negative test from **a pharmacy, clinic or doctor's office. If the child doesn't get tested, they can return 10 days after exposure to Covid-19 if symptom free. However, in order to return you must have a negative test result.** If your child arrives with any of the symptoms below, he/she will not be accepted into care.

Symptoms:

Fever of 100 degrees	Muscle and body aches
Fatigue	Nausea or vomiting
Headache	Diarrhea
Cough	Chills
Nasal congestion or runny nose	Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
Loss of taste or smell	
Sore throat	

State of Emergency Illness

If there is a State of Emergency due to illness. I will take all precautions and follow the instructions given to me by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, Jackson County Health Department and the CDC. If Mo department of health and senior services feels the daycare should close due to high illness in the community, I will contact you via text or phone. If your child is sick, please follow the above guidelines.

Travel and Group gatherings During State of Emergency Illness:

If you are traveling domestic or internationally to a place that is subject of travel restrictions under state and local guidance, please quarantine for 10 days at home or have a negative test **pharmacy, clinic or doctor's office.** Depending on circumstances we may require a doctor's clearance before child/ren can return.

If you are attending a group gathering more than what the city or state requires your child will have to quarantine for 10 days or have a negative tested.

If your child arrives with any of the above symptoms, he/she will not be accepted into care.
